Boats that float!

How good is your aim? Try your activities again today and see if your aim is any better!

Your task today is to make a boat that floats!

You can make a boat out of anything. See what you've got that you can use!

- A polystyrene food tray
- A washing up scourer/sponge (cut to look like the hull)
- Sculpted foil
- A fizzy drinks bottle
- A juice carton

Use garden sticks or lolly sticks to make masts. Secure them with blue tac or plasticine. Use fabric or paper for the sails. If you use paper you can draw your own cool design on them.

Older children might like to make origami boats. Use a sheet of A4 paper first, then you can make bigger boats using newspaper! There are lots of good online videos which show you how to do this. The last bit is the trickiest! Have a go! It's cool to do!

See whose boat can carry the most weight and still stay afloat!! Happy sailing!

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
