Introit: This joyful Eastertide

The president says:

In the name of the Father,
and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit. . .

All **Amen.**

The president greets the people

Alleluia. Christ is risen.

All **He is risen indeed. Alleluia.**

Words of introduction are said and all invited to bring those things to the Lord for which they ask forgiveness using the ancient responses:

Lord have mercy: **Lord have mercy** Christ have mercy: **Christ have mercy** Lord have mercy: **Lord have mercy**

Forgiveness is offered in the name of God.

Hymn: Jesus Christ is risen today (in place of the Gloria)

The Collect

Lord of all life and power, who through the mighty resurrection
of your Son overcame the old order of sin and death
to make all things new in him:

grant that we, being dead to sin and alive to you in Jesus Christ: may reign with him in glory;
to whom with you and the Holy Spirit
be praise and honour, glory and might, now and in all eternity. **Amen**

The Liturgy of the Word

At the end of each of the first two readings the reader says

This is the word of the Lord.

All **Thanks be to God.**

The Gospel Reading John 20: 1– 18.

The reader says:

The Lord be with you.

All: **And also with you.**

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John

All **Glory to you, O Lord.**

At the end This is the Gospel of the Lord.

All **Praise to you, O Christ.**

The Sermon

Prayers of Intercession

The Response: Lord, hear us. **Lord, graciously hear us.**

At the end: Merciful Father: **accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.**



The president introduces the Peace and then says:

The peace of the Lord be always with you

All **and also with you.**

Let us offer one another a sign of peace.

Hymn: Alleluia, alleluia! Hearts to heaven and voices raise (during which the table is prepared)

The Eucharistic Prayer

The Lord be with you

All **and also with you.**

Lift up your hearts.

All **We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

Praise is given and then:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and God of might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord
Hosanna in the highest.**

The prayer continues using the Lord's words and invoking the Holy Spirit, then:

Great is the mystery of faith: **Christ has died, Christ is risen,**

Christ will come again

Praise is give, ending with the words; for ever and ever. **Amen**

The Lord's Prayer

A period of silence is kept before the president introduces the prayer

All **Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory,
for ever and ever. Amen.**

The president breaks the bread.

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ.

All **Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread.**

Invitation to Spiritual Communion

Blessed are those who are called to His supper

Lord I am not worthy to receive You, but only say the word and I shall be healed

Alleluia. Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us. All **Therefore let us keep the feast. Alleluia.**

Post Communion Prayer

Hymn: Thine be the glory

The Blessing

The Lord be with you All **And also with you.**

.....and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit,
be among you and remain with you always. All **Amen.**

Go in peace to love and serve the Lord. Alleluia, Alleluia.

All **In the name of Christ. Alleluia, Alleluia.**
