



Tuesday, 12th May Beetle Drive

Here's a fun family game. The idea is to make a beetle by throwing a dice and then drawing the body parts. (If you haven't got a dice, write the numbers 1-6 on pieces of paper, cut as small cards and place in a pile. Make three sets, shuffle them and place face down. You then draw a card for your roll of the dice)

Everyone will need a piece of paper and a pencil.

1= eyes

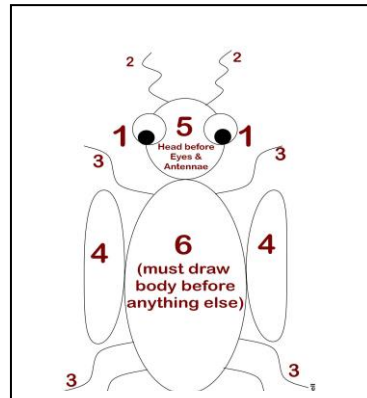
2=antennae

3=legs

4=wings

5= head

6=body



You have to throw a 6 to start your beetle and a 5 before you can add eyes or antennae. You need to roll a 3 for each of the 6 legs (and a 4 for each wing; a 1 for each eye and a 2 for each antenna!)

Scoring Points

To play more than one round and score points, the round is over when someone completes a beetle. Everyone adds up their points : get 1 point for every part of the body you have drawn.
