The Eucharist - Trinity Season and Ordinary Time (Said)

The president says:

In the name of the Father,
and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit.

All **Amen.**

The president greets the people

Grace, mercy and peace
From God our Father
And the Lord Jesus Christ be with you
and also with you.

All



Words of introduction are said and all invited to bring those things
to the Lord for which they ask forgiveness using the ancient responses:

Lord have mercy: **Lord have mercy,** OR
Christ have mercy: **Christ have mercy**
Lord have mercy: **Lord have mercy**

Forgiveness is offered in the name of God.

The Collect Concluding with: **Amen**

The Liturgy of the Word

At the end of the reading(s) the reader says

This is the word of the Lord.

All **Thanks be to God.**

The Gospel Reading

The reader says:

The Lord be with you. All: **And also with you.**
Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to N.

All **Glory to you, O Lord.**

At the end This is the Gospel of the Lord.

All **Praise to you, O Christ.**

Prayers of Intercession

The Response: Lord, hear us. **Lord, graciously hear us** Or Lord in your mercy: **Hear our prayer**

At the end: Merciful Father: **accept these prayers for the sake of your Son,
our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen**

The Peace The president introduces the Peace and then says:

The peace of the Lord be always with you All **and also with you.**
Let us offer one another a sign of peace.

The table is laid, and prayers over the gifts of bread and wine may be used, each ending with the response:

Blessed be God for ever.

This confession may be used:

**Almighty God, our heavenly Father
we have sinned against you
and against our neighbour
in thought and words and deed,
through negligence, through weakness,
through our own deliberate fault.
We are truly sorry
and repent of all our sins.
For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ,
Who died for us,
forgive us all that is past
and grant that we may serve you
in newness of life
to the glory of your name. Amen.**

The Eucharistic Prayer

All The Lord be with you
and also with you.
Lift up your hearts.
All **We lift them to the Lord.**
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
All **It is right to give thanks and praise.**
Praise is given and then:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord
Hosanna in the highest.**

The prayer continues using the Lord's words and invoking the Holy Spirit, then:

Great is the mystery of faith:
Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again

Praise is given, ending with the words; for ever and ever. Amen

The Lord's Prayer

A period of silence is kept before the president introduces the prayer

All **Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory,
for ever and ever. Amen.**

The president breaks the bread.

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ.

All **Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread.**

Invitation to Spiritual Communion

Blessed are those who are called to His supper
**Lord I am not worthy to receive You,
but only say the word and I shall be healed.**

The Agnus Dei may be said after the breaking of the bread:

**Lamb of God, you take away the
sin of the world, have mercy on us.**

**Lamb of God, you take away the

sin of the world, grant us peace.**

Post Communion Prayer

The Blessing

The Lord be with you All **And also with you.**

.....and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit,

All **In the name of Christ. Amen.**
