



Wednesday, 10th June Charades

Nearly everyone loves a game of charades! It's great for developing your kids' self-confidence! It can also be quite hysterical!

Decide on the categories you want to act out. Remember, no-one is allowed to talk! Then make sure everyone knows the clue for each:

Film - pretend you are filming; TV - draw a rectangle in the air; book - palms together and then open like opening a book

Then say how many words are in the title by holding up that many fingers.

If you want to break down syllables, hold up 1 finger for the 1st word; your second finger for the 2nd word. Then put 1,2 or 3 fingers against your arm to show the number of syllables that word has.

Younger children can play a simpler version, acting out a Disney or TV character; a farm animal; a wild animal; an insect.....
