Look around the churchyard in front of the church to find the answers to the first three questions.



1. Which country is mentioned on this memorial?



2. How many children did Laura have?



3. Who is this white memorial dedicated to?

Now head to the lych gate in Church Street.

4. How many houses can you find in Church Street that have “King” in their name?  
What are they?

Don't cross the road but walk up the High Street on the Talbot side.

5. Keep your eyes peeled for these clocks as you walk. Where will you find them? (not necessarily in this order!)



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6. Which numbers between 0 -10 are not used in the Sweetshop phone number?

Cross the road carefully at the crossing point by Cuckfield Bathrooms and walk up the road past Lloyds Chemist.

7. Look out for these two plaques as you walk up the High Street. Where are they?

10. Look out for these three benches as you walk.

11. What is the full name of the recreation ground?

12. What colour front door does Cuckfield House have?

Keep on the left- hand side of the road, but keep glancing to the other side!

Cross at the lights on the pedestrian crossing.  
Now follow the road up on the right- hand side.



14. Which house has a pig on guard by its front door?



Cross over the road by Pelham House and walk back towards the Queen's Hall.

17. What's the road number to Haywards Heath?


18. Just past the crossing lights, look back to find a post box hidden in the wall. What time is the collection on Saturdays?

23. Look out for the big old manor house called Marshalls on your right as you come close to the mini roundabout by the chemist. When was it built?

Turn right by the sweet shop down Ockenden Lane. Keep to the right side of the road and be very careful of traffic down here as there is no pavement. The next questions are all about animals!

24. Why is the king of the jungle beside the gate of Ockenden Manor?

Follow the lane round carefully as there is no pavement.

25. What animal opens the door of the Old Court House?

Be very careful as Ockenden Lane joins the main road.

26. What animal would have been very happy at this junction?
