Coin Subbuteo

Have your children wanted a table football? Why not make your own Subbuteo football? It is really rewarding to make your own and provides endless fun!

Get 10 x 2p or 10p coins for each side.

Paint your team of coins in your favourite colour kit so you can identify them easily!

Use a smaller coin for the football. You can paint it white and black!

You can use anything for your goal keeper like a piece of cut sponge or a cork.

If you have a large piece of paper you can always draw the pitch. Mark where your goals are going to be or you could make them out of an old cereal box or something similar.

Play like the old- fashioned game shove-ha'penny using a thick piece of card or an old credit card to push one of your players so it hits the smaller coin (football) and pushes it towards scoring a goal.

If the football touches one of your team's players you have another go. If not, play passes to the other team! Set a time limit and keep the scores! (contd.....)

Younger children will just enjoy playing shove ha'penny and see if they can score a goal. Or you could mark a piece of paper with circles to see where the coin falls. You could give a set number of points for each circle.
