**The Yes! - No! Game**

**This is a great game for helping kids think on their feet!**

Place a chair so it looks like an interview chair. Decide who is going to sit on the hot seat first. This child has to field a torrent of questions from the other players. In all his answers he is not allowed to say, "Yes!" or "No!" otherwise he is out!

The child being questioned can answer with different phrases like,

"You said so" "I never did!" "Maybe" ..... He is not allowed to use the same response in consecutive answers!

Children asking the questions have to think of ways to make the child in the hot seat use "Yes" or "No". eg asking the same question in a different way often catches people out; or saying, "You did, didn't you?"

Who can last the longest? You could use an egg timer, or time everyone to see who is the best question dodger!
